

Exports and imports declined by FV,7% and F.,0%, respectively, in Iuly $\Gamma \cdot \Gamma \cdot$

Merchandise exports decreased by Γ 7,7% in July Γ . Γ . compared to July Γ . 19. The value of exports amounted to 01/11% million riyals in July T.T., down from A1/9.1 million riyals in July T.19. This decrease originated mainly from oil exports, which fell by T9/IAE million riyals or £1,E% in the same period. The share of oil exports in total exports, therefore, decreased from V1, 19) to 70,9% (July Γ.Γ.). However, compared to the previous month (June Γ.Γ.), total merchandise exports increased by V-E7A million riyals or IV,7%.

Non-oil exports declined by Λ, Ψ year-on-year in July Γ.Γ., falling down to IV εΓε million riyals. Of the most important non-oil goods, "Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries" ("., &% of non-oil merchandise exports) declined by II,.% (-low million riyals) and "Plastics, Rubber and Articles thereof" ("., \% of non-oil merchandise exports) declined by 18, \% (-91\% million riyals) from July T.19. Non-oil exports increased compared to the previous month (June T.T.) by AF9 million rivals or 0,1%.

Merchandise imports declined by ".,o% (-17.0r. million rivals) in July r.r.. The value of imports amounted to ٣٧/٦٦1 million riyals in July Γ.Γ. compared to οε/ΙΛΙ million riyals in July Γ.19. This decrease was due to the decrease in many sections compared to July ۲.19, mainly "Vehicles and Associated Transport Equipment" (-75,7%) and "Machinery and Mechanical Appliances; Electrical Equipment" (-\(\tilde{\ ٦٠٨٦. million riyals or ١٥,٤%.

Ratio of Non-oil Exports to Imports at £7,5%

The ratio of non-oil exports to imports increased to ελ, ٣% in July Γ.Γ. compared to ٣0, I% in July ۲.19. This is due to the fact that the decrease in non-oil exports (-۸,۳%) was more muted than the decrease in imports (-\(\mathcal{V}\).,0%) during this period.

China is Saudi Arabia's main trading partner for merchandise trade

In July Γ.Γ., exports to China amounted to I. Tr willion riyals, rendering the country the main destination for exports of Saudi Arabia. Japan and South Korea followed next with ε٬ΛΓ٣ million riyals and ξ·οοΓ million riyals, respectively. India, United Arab Emirates, U.S.A, Singapore, Bahrain, Egypt, and South Africa were the other countries that ranked in the top 1. destinations. Exports of Saudi Arabia to those Ι. countries amounted to Υο΄Λ٩Λ million riyals, accounting for V., Γ% of the total exports.

Imports from China amounted to V₁οΛ9 million riyals in July Γ. Γ., rendering the country the main origin for imports of Saudi Arabia. U.S.A and United Arab Emirates followed next with imports of F'off million riyals and F'IAo million riyals, respectively. Germany, India, Italy, Bahrain, Japan, France and South Korea were the other countries that ranked in the top 1. countries for imports. Imports of Saudi Arabia from those Ι. countries amounted to ΓΓ/ΛΙΣ million rivals, accounting for 1.,1% of the total imports.



Top Five Customs Ports for Imports

9.0% million riyals of imports, corresponding to $\Gamma1,1\%$ of the total, entered the Kingdom from Jeddah Islamic Sea Port in July $\Gamma.\Gamma.$ Among the other major ports of entry for the imports were King Abdul-Aziz Port ($\Gamma1,\Gamma\%$), King Khalid International Airport ($\Gamma1,\Gamma\%$), King Fahad Airport ($\Gamma1,0\%$), and Riyadh (Dry Port) ($\Gamma1,\Sigma\%$). Those five ports together accounted for $\Gamma1,\Gamma\%$ of the total merchandise imports of the Kingdom.

Methodology


GASTAT's statistics on International trade are built on administrative records from Saudi Customs (non-oil) and the Ministry of Energy (oil). Saudi Arabia's merchandise exports and imports are classified according to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding Systems (Γ . IV), also known as the Harmonized System (HS), which is maintained by the World Customs Organization (WCO). The HS allows countries to classify traded products in an internationally standardized system of product names and codes. Oil exports refer to exported goods classified in Chapter Γ V (mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of the Harmonized System (HS). Non-oil exports refer to all other goods exported (including petrochemicals).
