

Non-oil exports rise by 1.1%, imports decline by 7.4% in Q4 2020

Overall merchandise exports decreased by 25.7% in Q4 2020 compared to Q4 2019. The value of exports amounted to 180.8 billion riyals in Q4 2020, down from 243.4 billion riyals in Q4 2019. This decrease originated mainly from oil exports, which fell by 63.3 billion riyals (-34.0%) in the same period. The share of oil exports in total exports decreased from 76.5% (Q4 2019) to 68.0% (Q4 2020). Compared to the previous quarter (Q3 2020), total merchandise exports increased by 18.9 billion riyals (+11.7%).

Non-oil exports increased by 1.1% year-on-year in Q4 2020, raising up to 57.9 billion riyals from 57.3 billion riyals in Q4 2019. The share of non-oil exports in total exports increased from 23.5% (Q4 2019) to 32.0% (Q4 2020). 'Plastics and Rubber and Articles Thereof', with a share of 31.9% in non-oil merchandise exports, increased by 14.4% and 'Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries' (with a share of 25.2% in non-oil merchandise exports) decreased by 5.2% from Q4 2019. Non-oil exports increased compared to the previous quarter (Q3 2020) by 4.5 billion riyals (+8.4%).

Merchandise imports decreased by 7.4% (10.8 billion riyals) in Q4 2020. The value of imports amounted to 134.1 billion riyals in Q4 2020 compared to 144.9 billion riyals in Q4 2019. This decrease was due to the decrease in many sectors compared to Q4 2019, mainly 'Vehicles and Associated Transport Equipment' (-22.2%) and 'Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries' (-13.6%). Imports, however, increased compared to the previous quarter (Q3 2020), by 17.0 billion riyals (+14.5%).

Ratio of Non-oil Exports to Imports increased to (+43.2%)

The ratio of non-oil exports to imports increased to 43.2% in Q4 2020 from 39.5% in Q4 2019 as a result of an increase in non-oil exports (+1.1%) in contrast to a decline in imports (-7.4%) during that period.

China is Saudi Arabia's main trading partner for merchandise trade

In Q4 2020, exports to China amounted to 34.5 billion riyals, making this country the main destination for exports of Saudi Arabia. Japan and India followed next with 17.9 billion and 17.8 billion riyals, respectively. United Arab Emirates, South Korea, were the other countries that ranked in the top 5 destinations. Exports of Saudi Arabia to those 5 countries amounted to 98.8 billion riyals, accounting for 54.6% of the total exports.

Imports from China amounted to 27.6 billion riyals in Q4 2020, making this country the main origin for imports of Saudi Arabia. U.S.A and United Arab Emirates, followed next with imports of 13.9 billion and 9.7 billion riyals, respectively. India, Germany, were the other countries that ranked in the top 5 countries for imports. Imports of Saudi Arabia from those 5 countries amounted to 64.3 billion riyals, accounting for 47.9% of the total imports.

Top Five Customs Ports for Imports

37.5 billion riyals of imports (27.9% of total imports), entered the Kingdom from Jeddah Islamic Sea Port in Q4 2020. Among the other major ports of entry for the imports were King Abdulaziz Port (18.6%), King Khalid International Airport (13.8%), Bat'ha (6.7%), and King Fahad Airport (6.0%). Those five ports together accounted for 73.0% of the total merchandise imports of the Kingdom.




Methodology

GASTAT's statistics on International trade are built on administrative records from Saudi Customs (non-oil) and the Ministry of Energy (oil). Saudi Arabia's merchandise exports and imports are classified according to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding Systems (2017), also known as the Harmonized System (HS), which is maintained by the World Customs Organization (WCO). The HS allows countries to classify traded products in an internationally standardized system of product names and codes. Oil exports refer to exported goods classified in Chapter 27 (mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of the Harmonized System (HS). Non-oil exports refer to all other goods exported (including petrochemicals).
