

Merchandise exports and imports decline by 20.7% and 4.4%, respectively, in Q1 2020

Merchandise exports in Q1 2020 recorded a decrease of 20.7%, corresponding to 51,518 million riyals, from Q1 2019, as they amounted to 197,844 million riyals in Q1 2020 compared to 249,362 million riyals in Q1 2019. This decrease was mainly due to a decrease of 21.9% in oil exports, corresponding to a decline of 42,076 million riyals. The share of oil exports in total exports declined from 77.0% (Q1 2019) to 75.8% (Q2 2020).

Non-oil exports declined by 16.5% compared to Q1 2019. The most important non-oil goods, "Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries" and "Plastics, Rubber and Articles thereof", which constituted 30.6% and 29.7%, respectively, of non-oil merchandise exports in Q1 2020, also recorded a decrease. Exports of "Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries", including Petrochemicals, declined by 18.9% (-3.407 million riyals) and "Plastics, Rubber and Articles thereof" recorded a decrease of 25.6% (-4.890 million riyals) from Q1 2019. Compared to the previous quarter (Q4 2019), exports decreased by 17.4% or 41,686 million riyals.

Merchandise imports in Q1 2020 recorded a decrease of 4.4%, corresponding to 5,719 million riyals, from Q1 2019, as they amounted to 124,099 million riyals in Q1 2020 compared to 129,818 in Q1 2019. This decrease was due to the decrease in many sections compared to Q1 2019, mainly "Machinery and Mechanical Appliances; Electrical Equipment" (-4.0%) and "Vehicles and Associated Transport Equipment" (-6.3%). On the other hand, imports increased for "Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries" (+7.8%) and "Base metals and articles of base metal" (+8.3%). Compared to the previous quarter (Q4 2019), imports decreased by 4.7% or 6,132 million riyals.

Ratio of Non-oil Exports to Imports at 38.6%

The ratio of non-oil exports to imports decreased to 38.6% in Q1 2020 compared to 44.2% in Q1 2019. This is due to the decrease in non-oil exports, which was much sharper (-16.5%) than the decrease in imports (-4.4%) during this period.

China is Saudi Arabia's main trading partner for merchandise trade

In Q1 2020, exports to China amounted to 35,046 million riyals, rendering the country the main destination for exports of Saudi Arabia. Japan and India followed next with 20,165 million riyals and 19,571 million riyals, respectively. South Korea, U.S.A, United Arab Emirates, Egypt, Taiwan, Bahrain, and Singapore were the other countries that ranked in the top 10 destinations. Exports of Saudi Arabia to those 10 countries amounted to 135,228 million riyals, accounting for 68.4% of the total exports.

Imports from China amounted to 20,866 million riyals in Q1 2020, rendering the country the main origin of imports of Saudi Arabia. U.S.A and United Arab Emirates followed next with 13,988 million riyals and 8,459 million riyals, respectively. India, Germany, Japan, France, Italy, South Korea, and Egypt were the other countries that ranked in the top 10 countries for imports. Imports of Saudi Arabia from those 10 countries amounted to 78,505 million riyals, accounting for 63.3% of the total imports.

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


Top Five Customs Ports for Imports

37,235 million riyals of imports, corresponding to 30.0% of the total, entered the Kingdom from Jeddah Islamic Sea Port. Among the other major ports of entry for the imports were King Abdul-Aziz Port (20.5%), King Khalid International Airport (11.6%), Bat'ha (8.2%), and King Fahad Airport (5.8%). Those five ports together accounted for 76.2% of the total merchandise imports of the Kingdom.

Methodology

GASTAT's statistics on International trade are built on administrative records from Saudi Customs (non-oil) and the Ministry of Energy (oil). Saudi Arabia's merchandise exports and imports are classified according to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding Systems (2017), also known as the Harmonized System (HS), which is maintained by the World Customs Organization (WCO). The HS allows countries to classify traded products in an internationally standardized system of product names and codes. Oil exports refer to exported goods classified in Chapter 27 (mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of the Harmonized System (HS). Non-oil exports refer to all other goods exported (including petrochemicals).


