IPI increases by 1.3% in January 2025

Preliminary results indicate a 1.3% increase in the Industrial Production Index (IPI) in January 2025 compared to the same month of the previous year (January 2024), supported by the rise in manufacturing activity, and water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities. On a monthly basis, the index remained stable at the same performance level as the previous month.

Sub-index of mining and quarrying activity

In January 2025, the sub-index of mining and quarrying activity decreased by 0.4% compared to the same month of the previous year. Saudi Arabia decreased its oil production to 8.92 million barrels per day in January 2025 compared to 8.96 million barrels per day in January 2024. On a monthly basis, the sub-index of mining and quarrying activity increased by 0.1%.

Sub-index of manufacturing activity

Compared to January of the previous year, the sub-index of manufacturing activity increased by 4.0%, supported by an increase in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products which increased by 4.3%, and the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products which increased by 4.2%.

On a monthly basis, the sub-index of manufacturing activity showed an increase of 0.3%, supported by the rise in the activity of the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products, which increased by 0.1%, and the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products which increased by 0.5%.


Sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply, and sub-index of water supply, sewage, and waste management and remediation activities


The sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply activity recorded an annual decrease of 1.7%. While the sub-index of water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities increased by 12.8%.

Based on the month-on-month trend, the sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply activity decreased by 9.4%. While the sub-index of water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities increased by 8.7% .

IPI by main economic activities

The index of oil activities in January 2025 increased by 0.4% compared to the same month of the previous year. The index of non-oil activities increased by 3.6%. Based on the month-on-month trend, the index for oil activities increased by 0.1%, and the index of non-oil activities decreased by 0.2%.









Figure3. Monthly growth rate of sub-indices according to ISIC4
