

PPI in Saudi Arabia records an increase of 1.0 % in November 2025

Producer Price Index (PPI) in Saudi Arabia recorded an increase of 1.0% in November 2025 compared to the corresponding month of the previous year (November 2024). The increase was mainly driven by higher prices in the manufacturing sector by 0.9 % electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply by 0.5% and water supply, sewerage, and waste management activities by 11.1 %

Manufacturing sector records yearly growth in November 2025

Manufacturing sector recorded an increase of 0.9% driven by a 1.6% rise in prices for the manufacture of refined petroleum products, as well as increases in the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products and the manufacture of fabricated metal products (excluding machinery and equipment), which rose by 0.6% and 3.8% respectively.

By contrast, prices for the manufacture of paper and paper products declined by 2.2%. Prices also decreased for the manufacture of rubber and plastics products by 1.6% and for the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 0.4%

Year-on-year changes in electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply, as well as water, sewerage, and waste management activities

Price Index for electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply increased by 0.5% while the index for water supply, sewerage, and waste management activities rose by 11.1% in November 2025.

Manufacturing sector records month-on-month decline in November 2025

Manufacturing Price Index decreased by 0.4% month-on-month, driven by a 0.6% decline in prices for the manufacture of refined petroleum products. Prices for the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products, and for the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products fell by 1.1% and 0.8% respectively.

Month-on-month changes in electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply, and water supply, sewerage, and waste management activities

Price Index for electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply decreased by 0.1% while the index for water supply, sewerage, and waste management activities remained stable in November 2025 compared to October of the same year

Figure 2. Time series of PPI by main divisions for November 2025





Figure 3. Annual percentage changes in prices of manufacturing activities for November 2025 (%)



Methodology and quality

The Producer Price Index (PPI) is an economic indicator that reflects relative changes in domestic product prices, based on data from the Producer Price Survey, which is conducted on a sample of industrial establishments operating in the targeted industrial activities. These activities include manufacturing, electricity and gas supply, and water supply, sewerage, waste management, and remediation activities.
