


Number of Umrah performers exceeds 10.9 million in Q3 of 2025

Statistics showed that the total number of Umrah performers, both internal and external, during Q3 of 2025 reached 10,969,639, including 6,586,906 males and 4,382,733 females. The number of Umrah performers arriving from outside the Kingdom reached 4,322,199 during Q3 of 2025. Internal Umrah performers recorded the highest percentage of the total performers, reaching 6,647,440, of whom 4,522,017 were males and 2,125,423 were females. The number of Saudi performers reached 2,913,080, representing 43.8% of the total internal Umrah performers.

External Umrah performers by sex


Figure 1. Distribution of external Umrah performers by sex (percentage)

Data showed that the total number of external Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025 reached 4,322,199, including 2,064,889 male Umrah performers, representing 47.8% of all external Umrah performers, while the number of female Umrah performers reached 2,257,310, accounting for 52.2% (Figure1).

External Umrah performers by entry ports


Figure 2. Distribution of external Umrah performers entry ports (percentage)

Statistics indicated that 82.4% of external Umrah performers entered via airports, 16.9% arrived through land ports, and 0.7% arrived through seaports, representing a share of the total external Umrah performers (Figure 2).

Internal Umrah performers by sex and nationality

The results showed that the total number of internal Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025 reached approximately 6,647,440. Among them, Saudi Umrah performers recorded 2,913,080, representing 43.8% of all internal Umrah performers, while non-Saudi Umrah performers totaled 3,734,360, accounting for 56.2%. Results also indicated that the number of male internal Umrah performers was approximately 4,522,017, equivalent to 68% of the total, whereas female internal Umrah performers numbered around 2,125,423, representing 32% (Figure3).

Patterns for internal Umrah performers by accompanying groups

Results showed that 65.4 % of internal Umrah performers performed Umrah with their families, while 30.3 % performed individually. In contrast, performing Umrah with friends represented the lowest percentage, accounting for 4.3 % of the total internal Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025.

Internal Umrah performers by administrative region

According to the results of statistics, Umrah performers from Makkah Region represented the highest percentage of internal Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025, reaching 2,580,955, accounting for 38.8% of total internal Umrah performers. The number of Umrah performers from Riyadh Region reached 1,466,226, representing 22.1% of the total. Meanwhile, the number of Umrah performers from Al-Baha Region amounted to 41,208 accounting for 0.6% of total internal Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025.

Internal Umrah performers by frequency

Number of internal Umrah performers who performed Umrah once reached 6,411,943, with males representing 68.3% and females accounting for 31.7%. Meanwhile, the number of internal Umrah performers who performed Umrah more than once during Q3 of 2025 amounted to 235,497, representing 3.5% of total internal Umrah performers during the same period.

External and internal Umrah performers by month

Statistics showed that September recorded the highest number of external Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025, accounting for 34.9% with 1,508,407 Umrah performers. In contrast, July recorded the lowest number of external Umrah performers, with 1,372,163 As for internal Umrah performers, the results indicated that August also topped the months during Q3 in terms of the number of Umrah performers, recording 2,682,934, which represents 40.4% of total internal Umrah performers during the same period. Meanwhile, July ranked lowest, with 1,982,150 internal Umrah performers.


External and internal Umrah performers by age group

Umrah performers aged (35-44) years represented the highest percentage of external Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025, accounting for 17.3% of the total, according to administrative data. The age group above +65 years constituted the lowest percentage, representing 10.4%. On the other hand, internal Umrah performers aged (25-34) recorded the highest share among internal Umrah performers during Q3 of 2025, accounting for 25.6 % of the total, according to the results of the statistical survey. Meanwhile, internal Umrah performers aged above 65 years represented the lowest percentage, accounting for 2.3%.

External and internal visitors to Medina

Statistics showed that the total number of external visitors to Madinah during Q3 of 2025 reached 2,848,384 visitors, with males representing 48.2% and females accounting for 51.8%. The results also indicated that the total number of internal visitors to Madinah for religious purposes during the same period reached 2,258,929 visitors, including 1,254,611 Saudi visitors representing 55.5% of the total. Meanwhile, the number of non-Saudi internal visitors reached 1,004,318, representing 44.5%. Male internal visitors accounted for 64.9%, compared to 35.1% for females (Figure4).
